

## DIVERSITY AND INCLUSION


MAX as an organization, is committed to the principles of respect, value, and inclusion of all individuals regardless of their ethnic origin, gender, age, physical ability, and education.


MAX Exec Team by gender 2025




Event Speakers by ethnicity 2025

*The MAX Scholarship Fund (MSF) awards well-rounded High school and University students who are eager to make an impact, learn and create. Winners are students who have contributed to their communities and Canada at large, achieved above-average marks, and are recognized by their peers.*

## 2025 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

This year we awarded **69** scholarships worth **\$309,000** to Muslim students in high school and university across Canada. Our **scholarship reception** took place in person on **September 10, 2025** and was attended by well over 100 sponsors, scholars, and community members.

## GROWTH

Since we started the program in 2016, we have grown immensely! In 2016, we awarded 7 scholarships worth \$35,000. In 2020, we awarded 40 scholarships worth \$178,000, and by 2025 MSF awarded \$309,000 worth of scholarships to 69 students. Ten years of dedication and commitment from our community.

## SERVING A DIVERSE COMMUNITY

Our scholarship program provides diverse opportunities for students from different ethnic backgrounds to receive financial aid for their education and growth. We recognize there are gaps within our community as it relates to financial supports and the MSF is one of the avenues we are building upon to address those barriers. We partner with a local organization, BridgeTO that provides scholarships, and program access to underserved BIPOC students in the GTA.



# MENTORSHIPS

A professional mentorship program that connects early career professionals with seasoned professionals who provide career-related guidance and support as mentors, to catalyze excellence in the Canadian Muslim community.

## 2025 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- 224** New Mentor - Mentee pairs in 2025
- 212** Mentors intake applications **+15% increase**
- 354** Mentees intake applications **+16% increase**
- 16** In-person and virtual national events

In 2025, **MAX Mentorships** expanded its national footprint and deepened industry engagement, connecting a growing network of mentors and mentees across key sectors.

The top three industries were **Technology, Consulting, and Finance**, with Technology being the #1 industry nationwide in terms of mentor demand.

MAX Mentorships hosted a total of **16** events, consisting of **6** in-person gatherings and **4** virtual webinars. Among the in-person events, three were speed-matching events, while the other three were summer networking events, held in **Toronto, Montreal and Vancouver**. These events provided participants with invaluable opportunities to connect, collaborate, and expand their professional networks in dynamic settings.

# BOARDS

A mentorship program designed to prepare accomplished professionals from underrepresented communities for Board of Directors positions, connecting them with seasoned board members for guidance and skill-building.

Launched in 2025, **MAX Boards – Board Leadership Mentorship Program** onboarded **43** mentees and matched them with **22** mentors, including **15** senior cohort mentors and **7** junior cohort mentors, fostering meaningful one-on-one mentorship. The program formed a partnership with **BIPOC Executive Search** to enhance board readiness and early feedback has been positive, with participants reporting increased confidence and a stronger understanding of governance and boardroom dynamics.

The program drives impact across the Muslim community by promoting:

- **Representation:** Equipping Muslims to hold decision-making seats on boards, building visibility of Muslim excellence in leadership spaces.
- **Pipeline of Future Leaders:** Preparing mid-career and emerging professionals for governance roles and fostering community influence and advocacy.
- **Excellence:** Elevating governance skills to globally recognized standards (ICD/NACD), positioning Muslims as trusted, competent, and effective board members.
- **Network Effect:** Alumni mentor the next cohorts, creating a self-sustaining cycle of guidance, opportunity, and influence.

Through these initiatives, MAX Boards cultivates the next generation of Muslim leaders, ensuring their perspectives help shape policy, philanthropy, and corporate strategy while strengthening diversity and inclusion in boardrooms globally. Plans for 2026 include the launch of Cohort Two and the expansion of the mentor pool with seasoned board members across sectors, strengthening pathways for diverse executives to access board opportunities.

# CEO PANEL SERIES

C-LEVEL PROGRAMS

A speaker series that brings together distinguished CEOs from the community to share their career journeys, leadership insights, and strategies for success, inspiring the next generation of professionals and entrepreneurs to reach new heights in their industries.



In 2025, MAX expanded the reach of the **CEO Panel Series**, spotlighting distinguished leaders from our community and offering attendees the chance to gain firsthand insights, learn from their journeys, and explore strategies for success in today's fast-paced business landscape.

This year, MAX hosted three CEO Panel Series events, including a Senior Finance Panel, bringing together over **340 attendees** and featuring **13 senior executives** from diverse industries such as Anson Funds, OPTrust, TD, Manulife and more. Each event provided thought-provoking discussions and opportunities for participants to engage directly with seasoned leaders, expand their professional networks, and gain actionable insights to accelerate their own careers and ventures.

# INDUSTRY LEADERS PANEL SERIES

C-LEVEL PROGRAMS

Launched in Montreal and Ottawa in 2025, this flagship speaker series spotlights accomplished Muslim leaders who share practical insights, lived experiences, and career strategies from across industries.

## Montreal

In 2025, the **MAX Industry Leaders Panel** launched in **Montreal** with two impactful events: *"Achieving Excellence in a Diverse Work Environment"* in **February** and *"Unlocking Excellence: Driving Lasting Impact with Mindset and Action"* in **October**, bringing together **145** attendees and **12** senior speakers. The sessions featured accomplished Muslim leaders from diverse industries sharing insights on leadership, career growth, and professional strategy.

By tapping into Montreal's diverse Muslim Francophone community and offering accessibility for both **English** and **French** attendees, the program provided fresh perspectives and fostered inclusive networking and mentorship opportunities. Attendees engaged directly with speakers, gained actionable guidance, and strengthened connections across the city's professional Muslim community.

## National Capital Region (Ottawa)

In **November 2025**, the **MAX Industry Leaders Panel** held its first-ever event in the **National Capital Region (Ottawa)**, titled *"The Future of AI: Careers and Applications"*, attracting **90** attendees and featuring **6** senior speakers. The session brought together accomplished Muslim leaders from a variety of industries to share insights on leadership, career development, and professional strategy.

By introducing the program to a new city with brand new speakers and participants, attendees were able to engage directly with experts, gain practical guidance, and build meaningful connections. This event also marked the official launch of MAX NCR, establishing a new hub for professional development, mentorship, and networking within the National Capital Region Muslim community.



# AI & BEYOND

DISRUPTIVE TECHNOLOGIES

A program launched in 2024 that equips mid- to senior-level professionals with the knowledge and strategies to integrate AI technologies into their businesses, driving both innovation and value.



Since its launch in 2024, **MAX AI** has become a leading program equipping mid- to senior-level professionals with actionable insights on how AI and related technologies are transforming industries. To date, the program has successfully hosted **six events**—including **three panels**, **one mock trial**, and **two workshops**—bringing together over **25 senior AI leaders** and attracting **500+ attendees**.

The mock trial in 2025 offered a unique, interactive experience, putting AI “on trial” and inviting the audience to serve as the jury. Experts debated whether AI’s productivity gains put professionals who don’t adopt it at a disadvantage, explored the accessibility and trustworthiness of AI in the workplace, and demonstrated AI tools like ChatGPT, Superhuman, and Cursor in real-world business workflows.

Across all sessions, participants gained **practical strategies for integrating AI** into their organizations, explored real-world applications across industries, and connected with the broader AI community, fostering collaborations that drive innovation and industry impact.

# CYBERSECURITY

DISRUPTIVE TECHNOLOGIES

A program launched in 2024 that offers an in-depth exploration of the fast-evolving cybersecurity landscape, featuring top experts who share essential strategies and real-world examples to safeguard against digital threats.



Since its launch in 2024, **MAX Cybersecurity** has become a leading program for professionals and the broader community to deepen their understanding of digital security. Since inception, the program has hosted **two professional panel events for Cybersecurity Awareness Month**—including in 2025, the second annual panel titled *Mastering the Art of Attack & Defense*—as well as a **Cybersecurity for Seniors workshop at ISNA**, bringing together over **10 senior cybersecurity leaders** and engaging **300+ attendees**.

Panelists have shared real-world examples of security breaches, explored why cybersecurity is essential across all sectors, and provided actionable strategies **to stay ahead of evolving threats**. Through these sessions, MAX Cybersecurity has equipped participants with the knowledge, tools, and best practices needed to navigate the growing complexities of the digital landscape, fostering safer and more resilient professional and community environments.

# ENTREPRENEURSHIP

A program designed to equip Muslim founders with the tools, knowledge, and peer support needed to strengthen their ventures and drive sustainable growth.

In 2025, **MAX Entrepreneurship** strengthened support for aspiring and growth stage founders through curated convenings that expanded access to capital, customers, and peer learning. Highlights included a Ramadan gathering connecting entrepreneurs with active investors and a June panel **"How to Get Your First 50 Customers"**, where experienced founders shared early stage go to market strategies.

These ecosystem-building efforts culminated in the launch of **Barakah Labs**, a 6-week **equity-free accelerator** hosted at the MaRS Waterfront in downtown Toronto, supporting a cohort of 12 founders with the tools, mentorship, and networks needed to scale their ventures. At the end of the program, founders showcased their progress and pitched their startups at Demo Day, featuring **high-impact ventures** across **security, health-tech, climate, creator tools, and AI infrastructure**.




# MAXPITCH

A program launched to support Muslim entrepreneurs connecting founders with investors, mentorship, and a curated network, providing a structured pathway to scale their ventures and accelerate growth.

In 2025, **MAXPitch** hosted three live episodes, a VC/LP dinner, and its first in-person Live Pitch Night, marking a major milestone as the program expanded from virtual to professional in-person events. These initiatives brought together **140+** founders, **115+** investors, and showcased **24+** startups, resulting in over **\$1.7M** raised to support the next stage of these ventures.

Participants gained opportunities to refine their pitches, receive feedback from seasoned investors, and build lasting connections with peers and mentors. By fostering high-quality programming and curated investor access, MAXPitch strengthened the broader investment ecosystem for Muslim entrepreneurs, helping founders turn their ideas into scalable, high-impact businesses.

# WOMEN IN LEADERSHIP

A program with a mission to celebrate, inspire and cultivate leadership excellence in North American-Muslim women. The program focuses on Recognition, Leadership, and Network & Partnerships, thereby connecting and mobilizing Muslim women across North America to institute a strong and sustainable network.



Launched in Toronto in July 2017, **MAX Women in Leadership** has hosted **10+** professional development events and workshops, featuring **50+** leading industry speakers and engaging **1,000+** attendees to date.

In 2025, WIL hosted its 5th Annual International Women's Day (IWD) event on February 28, generously sponsored for the fifth consecutive year by McCarthy Tétrault. Centered on the theme **The Essence of Success**, the event, Women at Work: Embracing Equity, Inclusivity, and Opportunity, explored strategies for women's professional development, including upskilling, reskilling, retention, and mentorship.

This year, WIL hosted **three** key events—IWD, an Islamic Painting Workshop, and The Art of Becoming Her—featuring 14 senior professionals as speakers. The top impacts of these events were career acceleration and empowerment, visibility and representation, and networking and mentorship.

In 2025, WIL also partnered with **12+** Muslim women-owned businesses and launched its social media presence in June, reaching over 300 followers organically within a few months. Looking ahead, WIL will expand into **Montreal** and **Calgary** and soon launch a career accelerator program, **Emerging Women in Leadership**, to support early- to mid-career women professionals in building skills, networks, and pathways to leadership roles.

# EXECUTIVE LEADERSHIP SERIES

A program launched in 2025 in partnership with PwC, that empowers seasoned senior professionals to break through into executive leadership. The program provides advanced training, personalized mentorship, and access to a strong network to prepare participants for the next step in their career growth.



The **MAX Executive Leadership Series** is a professional development program that selects a cohort of rising senior professionals through a competitive application and interview process. In 2025, the program received 45 applications, of which **27** participants were accepted, and featured **28** industry speakers. Last year, it was delivered as a six-part program, with modules including **Executive Communication & Presence**, **Managing Your Brand**, **Managing Stakeholders (Upwards & Downwards)**, **Building Teams**, **Establishing Your Network (Internal & External)**, and **the Art of Persuasion**.

Through hands-on experiences, real-world case studies, and mentorship from senior leaders, participants develop advanced leadership skills, expand their professional networks, and gain the tools and guidance needed to accelerate their progression into executive leadership roles. The program is flexible in structure, with future editions offering a slightly reduced module count to focus on core leadership competencies.

# CIRCLES

PROFESSIONAL NETWORKING

*A program that connects ambitious visionaries across disciplines into tight-knit, discipline-specific circles of ~10 members, fostering collaboration, mentorship, and collective success.*

Since its launch in 2024, **MAX Circles** has grown to over **250 members** across **29 circles**, including C-Suite executives, world-renowned surgeon-scientists, founding entrepreneurs, and senior finance and asset management professionals. The program has become a powerful platform for professional growth, with many members achieving significant milestones such as promotions, transitions into larger leadership roles, awards, and other career-defining accomplishments.

In 2025, MAX Circles hosted **10** intimate monthly dinner socials across the GTA, providing members with meaningful networking and relationship-building opportunities. The flagship November **Interdisciplinary Checkpoint** brought together Circle leads and high performers to collaborate, share insights, and strengthen cross-industry connections.

Looking ahead, the program will introduce **Reciprocity Hour** in 2026, a structured collaboration model inspired by Wayne and Cheryl Baker, designed to foster intentional peer support and accelerate collective impact across Circles.

# CONNECT

PROFESSIONAL NETWORKING

*A moderated, subscription-based platform designed to foster mentorship, collaboration, and career mobility across the MAX professional community.*

Launched in 2024, **MAX Connect** has grown into a dynamic ecosystem connecting professionals across all career stages, from senior executives to graduating students. The platform now includes **100+** senior executives spanning industries such as law, banking, healthcare, asset management, entrepreneurship, technology, and finance, creating direct pathways for mentorship, referrals, and opportunity sharing.

To date, the platform has maintained a **100% response rate**, meaning every request shared has received at least one reply, with members consistently stepping up to support one another. Requests have ranged from founders seeking mentorship to register investment funds, professionals exploring careers in Responsible AI Strategy and Governance, founders looking for go-to-market advice on wealth-tech platforms, and healthcare professionals aiming to connect with life sciences researchers.

Through curated job postings, business introductions, and peer-to-peer engagement, members have secured interviews, expanded their networks, and built meaningful relationships with accomplished leaders in their fields. As one member shared, the program has been “incredibly rewarding” and has expanded both their network and career prospects.

By providing year-round access to an exclusive and values-aligned professional network, MAX Connect continues to strengthen career mobility within the community, fostering a culture of collaboration, support, and shared success.
